## 1. What DUI programs does Pathways offer?

Pathways offers both first offender and multiple offender programs

### Wet/Reckless

- 6 week: \$474.00

### First Offender

- 3 Month: \$805.00
- 6 Month: \$1,074.00
- 9 Month: \$1,540.00

### Multiple Offender

- 18 Month: \$2,041.00

## 2. What are Pathways' enrollment hours? Where do I go to enroll?

All enrollments are held at Pathways on 430 Teegarden Ave, Yuba City, Ca 95991

- Enrollments are done on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Monday – Friday 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM & 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM
- Enrollment appointments can also be made via telephone.
- Spanish enrollments are done on Friday's from 8-11 & 1-3

Reinstatement and Transfer-In enrollments are only by appointment. Please call Pathways at (530) 674-4530 to schedule your enrollment appointment. *(We do not schedule same day appointments)*

## 3. What am I required to bring in to enroll?

- Picture ID
- California driver's license number or X number
- Court referral if courts are requiring the program or a DMV K2 printout (no more than 30 days old)
- Down payment of \$230.00
- Violation Date

## 4. What forms of payments are accepted?

- Cash
- Check(down payment and last payment cannot be in the form of a check)
- Credit Card
- Money Order

Payments are accepted Monday – Friday from 8:00 AM to 8:30 PM
